Request: What are the respective contributions percentages, towards joint and common costs, for each of the services referred to above?

Response: Contribution is the difference between revenues (Item No. 53) and long run incremental costs (Item No. 54). Contribution from services like Switched Access Local Transport provides the economic support for Universal Service. Contribution as a percent of incremental cost for each of the intrastate services shown as being "at risk" in item No. 53 is as follows:
