- CMU _____ 16, 1992, which encompassed Documents Nos. 13485-92 through 13491-92, most of which
- CTR _____ have already been returned to Bell. Further, the November 16 request and underlying
- EAG _____ documents did not identify the page numbers by the document requests to which they were
- LEG _____ responsive. Thus, we cannot tell which document of the second request contains the pages
- LIN _____ which you have cross-referenced. At minimum, you need to identify which production
- OPC _____ request the identified pages were filed with. If your records show that the document(s) was
- RCH _____ (were) returned to you, then you must submit the line by line justification again.
- SEC _____ If a revised filing which meets the requirements of the rule is not received by the
- WAS _____ Director of the Division of Records and Reporting within 15 days of the date of this letter,
- OTH _____ Staff will recommend that the Prehearing Officer deny the request pursuant to Rule 25-
