DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the revised Standby Service (SS) rate schedule for which Gulf Power has requested approval be suspended?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes.

STAFF ANALYSIS: Gulf Power has petitioned the Commission for approval to implement a revised Standby Rate (SS) rate schedule. PSC Order No. 17159, issued as a result of Docket No. 850673-EU, Generic Investigation of Standby Rates for Electric Utilities, clearly prescribes the cost allocation and rate design methodology to be used when developing standby and supplemental rates. The Order further prescribes the terms and conditions associated with the provision of such service. The proposed tariffs should be suspended so that Staff can continue discovery to determine if the revised tariffs are reasonable and comport to Order No. 17159.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: No.

STAFF ANALYSIS: This docket should remain open until the Commission either approves or denies the Company's proposed tariff revision.
