SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S NOTICE  
OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), and pursuant to Rule 25.22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

1. The Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff") has issued several Audit Requests in connection with the Continuing Property Records (CPR) Review Audit of Southern Bell. Staff has requested, among other things, that Southern Bell furnish the following information:

2. Audit Request No. 5 - "For the attached underlined CPR entries of undetailed investment, please provide detail support documentation (work orders, invoices, journal entries, etc.) in support of the plant investment."

Audit Request No. 19 - "A physical inventory of CPR's for selected locations in the SE region was conducted during the period of 11/17-19/93 by joint teams of PSC and SBT Staff. The CPR records and locations (attached to Requests 14, 15) were

selected from the records provided by the Company to PSC EDP Group in Tallahassee.

The inventory found the attached listed discrepancies for the southern half of SE region. Please reconcile the quantities and provide support documentation (J.E., transfer documents, work orders, etc.) for each discrepancy at each location."

3. Some of the information being provided is clearly proprietary. For example, the information being provided contains unit cost information for plant purchased by Southern Bell for use in its provision of service to customers, internal company system user guides explaining how to perform business functions related to the maintenance of property records, and vendor-specific contractual information. Such information is specifically considered to be proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to § 364.183(3)(c), (3)(d) and (3)(e), Florida Statutes.

4. Consequently, because this information contains proprietary information, Southern Bell is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Staff to review this information without delay. Both the original of this notice and the individual requests have been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information. The written Staff Requests are attached hereto.
