2 Q. Please state your name and business address.

3 A. My name is MaryRose Sirianni. My business address is 101 East Gaines
4 Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0866.

5 Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?

6 A. I am currently an Engineer III in the Policy and Planning Section of the
7 Division of Communications at the Florida Public Service Commission.

8 Q. Briefly describe your educational background and work experience.

9 A. I graduated from West Virginia University in 1985 with a Bachelor of
10 Science in Mineral Processing Engineering. I am currently an MBA student in
11 the department of business at Florida State University. From 1987 to 1988 I
12 was employed by the Broward County Office of Planning. From 1988 to 1989 I
13 was employed by the Florida Department of Transportation.

14 I have been a member of the Commission Staff for four and a half years.
15 Since I joined the Commission I have worked on a wide array of
16 interdisciplinary projects. My work efforts over the last four and a half
17 years include the following:

- 18 • Preparation of the "1991 Biennium Report to the Legislature on the
19 Status of Competition in the Telecommunications Industry in Florida;"
- 20 • Prepared an ESSX/PBX technical comparison to determine their relative
21 cost differences;
- 22 • Assisting in the implementation of the Telecommunications Access System
23 Act;
- 24 • Reviews of capital recovery studies of telecommunications plant for
25 prudent investments;

- 1 • Assisting in the preparation of a Division of Communications/Research
2 report entitled "Florida Telecommunications Infrastructure: Local
3 Exchange Company Capabilities," which provides the status of local
4 exchange company capabilities from both a service and technology
5 perspective;
- 6 • Preparation of technical papers relating to various telecommunications
7 issues;
- 8 • Policy issues related to the rapidly developing telecommunications
9 infrastructure.

10 In addition, I have acted as docket coordinator on several occasions,
11 including the 1990 Centel Rate Case (Docket No. 890246) and the Investigation
12 into 1+ IntraLATA presubscription (Docket No. 930330).

13 Q. Please explain your involvement with the Regional BellSouth Audit?

14 A. I was one of two engineers assigned to work on the Regional BellSouth
15 audit in the area of research. This area included analysis of both BellSouth
16 internal research projects and BellSouth sponsored Bellcore projects. These
17 projects are mostly related to network evolution.

18 Q. Please explain how your experience qualifies you to assess the
19 reasonableness of the regulated/non-regulated allocation of these research
20 projects.

21 A. As discussed above, I have experience and knowledge in several different
22 areas of telecommunications and have worked on a variety of projects while at
23 the Commission. This diversity of experience has enabled me to have a broad
24 understanding of the entire telecommunications industry, beginning with the
25 technology and progressing through applications, services, and regulatory

1 | policies and treatment. In addition, I have attended various classes related
2 | to the Telecommunications network and its evolving infrastructure.

3 | Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in Docket 920260-TL?

4 | A. My testimony in this docket is to sponsor the research portions of
5 | Disclosure Nos. 17 through 20 and their associated workpapers in the Regional
6 | Audit of BellSouth which will be filed on December 17, 1993.

7 | Q. Have you previously testified before this Commission, or any other
8 | regulatory commission?

9 | A. No.

10 | Q. Does this conclude your testimony?


