MOTION TO DISMISS AND ANSWER TO PETITIONS

COMES NOW, SANLANDO UTILITIES CORPORATION, by and through its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.037, Florida Administrative Code, hereby responds to the Petitions (the "Petitions") of Tricia A. Madden, Jack R. Hiatt, and Robert E. Swett (the "Petitioners"), as follows:

1. The Petitions should be dismissed because the Petitioners have not alleged a sufficient substantial interest. Rule 25-22.036(7)2., Florida Administrative Code.

4. The Petitions should be dismissed because the Petitioners do not make any demand for relief. Rule 25-22.036(7)5., Florida Administrative Code.

5. Because Petitioners have not alleged any disputed issues of fact, these proceedings should be informal proceedings instead



6. SANLANDO UTILITIES CORPORATION denies each and every allegation of fact in the Petitions.


