
19 and 20 of the Citizens' First Request for Production filed February 11, 1994. As grounds for this motion, the utility would show the Commission that a disclosure of such documents and related information to anyone other than the attorneys and Public Counsel staff handling this document would require the disclosure of proprietary confidential business information, which disclosure should be prohibited pursuant to Section 367.156 of the Florida Statutes.
