COMPANY'S FIRST NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, ("Southern Bell" or "Company") and files pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), Florida Administrative Code, its First Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

1. On February 14, 1994, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission Staff") filed its First Set of Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents to Southern Bell. Some of the documents which will be produced for the Staff in response to the First Request for Production of Documents as well as Southern Bell's response to Request No. 1 of the First Set of Interrogatories, contain information which is exempted from public disclosure pursuant to §§ 119.07 and 364.183, Florida Statutes. Specifically, some of the documents and the interrogatory response contain, among other things, information concerning contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the Company or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms, customer specific information, information which is commercially valuable

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to Southern Bell and other proprietary confidential business information. The information is included as proprietary confidential business information under Section 364.138, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

2. Because the documents and the interrogatory response contain exempt information, Southern Bell is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Staff access to the documents and the interrogatory response without delay. The original of this Notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting and a copy of has been served on the Division requesting this information.
