rate case proceeding. The Court therein ordered Southern Bell to produce five internal audits and certain disciplinary panel recommendations.

- 2. The documents to be produced are clearly proprietary. For example, the documents include, among other things, internal audits, information derived directly from internal audits, employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, duties and responsibilities and other proprietary business information that, if disclosed publicly, would prove harmful to southern Bell. Such information is specifically considered to be proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to \$ 364.183(3),(3)(b) and (3)(f), Florida Statutes.
- proprietary information, Southern Bell is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code. The original of this notice has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information.
- 4. In addition to the aforementioned information, the Commission continues to hold material which the Supreme Court has determined to be either privileged, or subject to the work-product doctrine, or both. Obviously such materials are not subject to public disclosure. However, it appears that certain of the Commission's staff may intend to assert that portions of the material which is privileged, or subject to the work-product

doctrine, or both should be treated as if it were not. Pending resolution of this dispute, the Company asserts that all of this material must be treated as proprietary and confidential business information and herewith notices its intent to request confidential classification for this material within the time allowed by the Commission's Rules.
