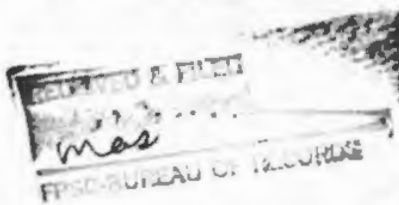

1. Sprint/United-Florida requests that the documents attached hereto as Attachment "A" be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 364.183, Florida Statutes (1991). Attachment "A" is an edited version of the documents on which the information asserted to be confidential has been blocked out by the use of an opaque marker. An unedited version of the documents included in Attachment "A" has been submitted to the Division of Records and Reporting on this date under a separate cover and with the information asserted to be confidential highlighted in yellow.

2. Document Nos. 1 through 9 of Attachment "A" were provided to the Division of Records and Reporting, together with a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification, on April 7, 1994, in Response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories, Nos. 12 n., 12 p., 12 r, 13 a., 13 b., 13 c., 13 d., 13 e. and 13 f.



Document No. 1 of Attachment "A" reflects the number of residence, business and toll access trunk lines served by the Fort Myers, Winter Park, Ocala and Avon Park DMS 200 or DMS 100/200 switches, Document No. 2 of Attachment "A" reflects the current utilization of the Fort Myers, Winter Park, Ocala and Avon Park switches by processor, trunks and lines, Document No. 3 of Attachment "A" reflects the type (DS-1 or DS-3) and quantity of terminals used with the Fort Myers, Winter Park, Ocala and Avon Park access tandem switches, Document Nos. 4 and 5 of Attachment "A" reflect the long-run average incremental cost of multiplexing DS-1 transmission capacity, Document Nos. 6 and 7 of Attachment "A" reflect the long-run average incremental cost of multiplexing an interoffice channel, and Document Nos. 8 and 9 of Attachment "A" reflect the long-run average incremental cost of multiplexing an interoffice channel. The highlighted and redacted portions of these documents should be considered confidential because disclosure of that information would harm the Company's ratepayers and/or the business operations of the Company.

4. The line-by-line and page-by-page justification required by Section 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative code, including statements concerning how the ratepayers and/or the business operations of the Company will be harmed if this information is disclosed to the public, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Attachment "B."

5. The information in Attachment "A" is intended to be and is treated by Sprint/United-Florida as private, confidential information and has not been disclosed to the public.

WHEREFORE, Sprint/United-Florida respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order declaring that the highlighted and redacted information in the documents in Attachment "A" is proprietary confidential business information and exempt from disclosure under the public records laws of the State of Florida.

Note 1: This information reflects the number of access trunks served by the Fort Myers, Winter Park and Ocala access tandem switches, as well as the residential and business lines and access trunks served by the Avon Park switch. In view of the fact that this docketed proceeding is focused on the opening of the switched access transport markets to competition, this information shows the size of the market on a access tandem switch basis. This market information is valuable to United as it faces competition in the switched access market. Providing this valuable competitive marketing information to United's competitors would allow those competitors to target specific United markets to the disadvantage of United and its other customer. United is not privy to its competitors' confidential marketing information, and it is fundamentally unfair to allow United's competitors to receive that

which is not available to United. As such, this information is classified as "proprietary confidential business information in accordance with Section 364.183(3)(a) and (3)(b), Florida Statutes, and is exempt from Chapter 119, the Florida Open Records Act.

Note 2: This information reflects the current utilization of United's four access tandem switches located in Fort Myers, Winter Park, Ocala and Avon Park. In view of the fact that this docketed proceeding is focused on the opening of the switched access transport markets to competition, this information shows the relative size of the market on a tandem switch basis. This market information is valuable to United as it faces competition in the switched access market. Providing this valuable competitive marketing information to United's competitors would allow those competitors to target specific United markets to the disadvantage of United and its other customer. United is not privy to its competitors' confidential marketing information, and it is fundamentally unfair to allow United's competitors to receive that which is not available to United. As such, this information is classified as "proprietary confidential business information in accordance with Section 364.183(3)(a) and (3)(b), Florida Statutes, and is exempt from Chapter 119, the Florida Open Records Act.

Note 3: This information reflects the number of each type of transmission terminal used with each of United's four access tandem switches located in Fort Myers, Winter Park, Ocala and Avon Park. In view of the fact that this docketed proceeding is focused on the

opening of the switched access transport markets to competition, this information shows the relative size of the market on a tandem switch basis. This market information is valuable to United as it faces competition in the switched access market. Providing this valuable competitive marketing information to United's competitors would allow those competitors to target specific United markets to the disadvantage of United and its other customer. United is not privy to its competitors' confidential marketing information, and it is fundamentally unfair to allow United's competitors to receive that which is not available to United. As such, this information is classified as "proprietary confidential business information in accordance with Section 364.183(3)(a) and (3)(b), Florida Statutes, and is exempt from Chapter 119, the Florida Open Records Act.

Note 4: This information reflects United's incremental cost of providing multiplexing channel banks and/or transmission terminals. In view of the fact that this docketed proceeding is focused on the opening of the switched access transport markets to competition, this information shows United's incremental cost of providing essential elements of its switched access transport service. This incremental cost information is valuable to United as it faces competition in the switched access market. Providing this incremental cost information to United's competitors would allow those competitors to know where they can price their competitive services in relation to United's in order to capture United's customers to the detriment of United and its other customers. United is not privy to its competitors' confidential cost

information, and it is fundamentally unfair to allow United's competitors to receive that which is not available to United. As such, this information is classified as "proprietary confidential business information in accordance with Section 364.183(3)(a) and (3)(b), Florida Statutes, and is exempt from Chapter 119, the Florida Open Records Act.
