**ATTORNEY GENERAL'S MOTION TO STRIKE SOUTHERN BELL'S REPLY TO THE
ATTORNEY GENERAL'S RESPONSE TO SOUTHERN BELL'S MOTION FOR RETURN
OF DOCUMENTS HELD IN CAMERA**

The Office of the Attorney General requests that Southern Bell's Reply to Attorney General's Response to Motion for Return of Documents Held in Camera be stricken.

On April 8th, 1994, Southern Bell filed a motion for return of documents held in camera. The documents in question could be determinative of major aspects of the pending case and should not be released without due consideration of the merits of their availability. Therefore, the Office of the Attorney General filed a response to Southern Bell's motion for

return of documents held in camera, on May 2nd, 1994, after requesting leave to respond from the Public Service Commission. The Attorney General's response detailed the reasons why the documents in camera should not be returned to Southern Bell at this time. On May 13, 1994, Southern Bell proceeded to file a reply to the Office of the Attorney General's response with the Public Service Commission.

The procedures for filing motions and responses with the Commission can be found in Rule 25-22.038(2)(b), Florida Administrative Code. Rule 25-22.038(2)(b), provides for filing motions with the Commission. Additionally, other parties involved in the proceeding may respond to motions with memoranda in opposition. F. A. C., r. 25-22.038(2)(b). However, Rule 25-22.038(2)(b) does not authorize a reply to a response to be filed with the Commission, nor did Southern Bell request leave to file a reply. Therefore, Southern Bell's reply to the Attorney General's response was not appropriate and should be stricken.
