
Staff has provided FPL with several written requests for information.

3. The material requested by Staff Document/Record Request (D/RR) Number 9 provided pursuant to the Commission's audit of FPL's fuel and purchased power cost recovery clause and generating performance incentive factor is intended to be and is treated by FPL as proprietary confidential business information as that term is defined in §366.093, Florida Statutes.
4. D/RR Number 9 requests confidential propriety business information concerning contractual data of FPL's vendors, which if disclosed, would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. The disclosure of contractual data would also impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. The material is confidential pursuant to §§366.093 (3)(d) and (e).
5. D/RR Number 9 is attached hereto as Attachment A.
6. Pursuant to F.A.C. Rule 25-22.006 (3)(a), as amended, this filing constitutes a temporary exemption from §119.07, F.S., for the material identified by the Staff D/RR delineated above which the Staff obtains, as defined in Subsection (1)(e) of

F.A.C. Rule 25-22.006. Furthermore, in accordance with Subsection (3)(d) of F.A.C. Rule 25-22.006, the Commission shall accord the material subject to the above listed D/RR's stringent safeguards against public disclosure.

WHEREFORE, FPL requests the Commission to treat the above-mentioned material identified as confidential in accordance with Subsection (3)(d) of Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, as amended.
