ORDER ADDING ADDITIONAL ISSUE

BY THE COMMISSION:

A preliminary list of issues was established in this docket pursuant to Order No. PSC-94-0277-PCO-TL, issued March 10, 1994. On June 10, 1994, the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit vacated in part and remanded for further proceedings two Federal Communications Commission's orders requiring the local exchange companies to set aside portions of their central offices for occupation and use by competitive access providers. Consequently, an additional issue will be added to the list of issues already established in this docket:

23(a). Should the Commission modify the Phase I order in light of the decision by the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit?

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by Chairman J. Terry Deason, as Prehearing Officer, that the additional issue set forth above shall be added to the list of preliminary issues established by Order No. PSC-94-0277-PCO-TL, issued March 10, 1994. It is further

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.038(2), Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
