Dear Ms. Bayo:

The purpose of this letter is to request the return of certain confidential information that was submitted to the Commission in anticipation of its use at a hearing held August 1-2, 1994. This information was not used in the course of the hearing and therefore may be returned to Gulf Power, the party which provided the information.

On July 22, 1994, a portion of the information requested by Staff via interrogatory 44 was provided pursuant to a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification dated July 21, 1994 and also pursuant to two documents entitled Confidentiality Representation dated July 22, 1994, and signed by Ms. Erstling and Ms. Meter of the Commission Staff. This information identified as Deposition Exhibit 9 and was the subject of questions and answers recorded in Volume 2 of the Deposition of James I. Thompson.

At the hearing, a stipulation was reached with regard to modification of language on sheet 6.29 of Gulf's Tariff for Retail Electric Service. This stipulation caused Issue 3 as identified in the Prehearing Order to become moot. This, in turn, eliminated Staff's need to use the confidential information described above in the course of the hearing.


