RE: DOCKET NO. 940743-WS - Joint application for transfer of majority organizational control of JACKSONVILLE SUBURBAN UTILITIES CORPORATION in Duval County from General Waterworks Corporation to United Water Resources Inc.

Issue 1: Recommendation that Jacksonville Suburban Utilities Corporation should not be exempted from compliance with Rule 25-30.030, F.A.C., which requires the utility to provide notice of its application in the manner and to the entities described in the rule. However, the utility should be exempted from full compliance with Rule 25-30.030(4)(c), F.A.C., as discussed in subsequent issues, to permit the utility to reduce the length of its territory description in its notice to individual customers and by publication.

Issue 2: Recommendation that Jacksonville Suburban Utilities Corporation should not be exempted from compliance with Rule 25-30.030(2), F.A.C., which requires the utility to provide this Commission with a complete legal description of the territory proposed to be transferred along with its request for a list of names and addresses.

Issue 3: Recommendation that Jacksonville Suburban Utilities Corporation should not be exempted from compliance with all provisions of Rule 25-30.030(5), F.A.C., which requires the utility to provide notice to certain entities.

**APPROVED**

Issue 4: Recommendation that Jacksonville Suburban Utilities Corporation should not be exempted from compliance with Rule 25-30.030(6), F.A.C., which requires the utility to notice each customer of the system being transferred by regular mail or personal delivery.

**APPROVED**

Issue 5: Recommendation that the utility be permitted to omit from its notice to each customer a full territory description as required by Rule 25-30.030(4)(c), F.A.C. The utility should be required to provide notice to each customer which simply identifies each county that has been affected by the transfer.

**APPROVED**

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Issue 6: Recommendation that the utility should not be exempted from compliance with Rule 25-30.030(7), F.A.C., which requires the utility to publish the notice once in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory affected by the transfer. However, the utility should be permitted to omit from the publication a full territory description as required by Rule 25-30.030(4)(c), F.A.C., and instead publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory affected a notice which resembles the customer notice and simply identifies each county that has been affected by the transfer.

Issue 7: Recommendation that this docket remain open to process the transfer application.
