# MEMORANDUM IN RESPONSE TO SOUTHERN BELL'S MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF PAGE AND WORD LIMITS

Time Warner AxS of Florida, L.P. ("Time Warner") by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.037, Florida Administrative Code, submits to the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") the following Memorandum in Response to BellSouth Telecommunications Inc.'s ("Southern Bell" or "Company") October 12, 1994, Motion for Modification of Page and Word Limits, and in support thereof states the following:

- 1. Time Warner does not object to Southern Bell's Brief exceeding the sixty page limit set forth in Rule 25-22.056(1)(d), Florida Administrative Code. While some parties address only a limited number of issues, Southern Bell must address each issue in this proceeding. Thus, Time Warner agrees that the number of consolidated dockets in this proceeding may warrant Commission latitude in terms of page limits for Southern Bell's brief.
- 2. Fairness dictates that the parties proceed within the same limitations under the rules unless appropriate relief has been afforded by the Commission. Time Warner does not object to Southern Bell exceeding the fifty word position summary limit required by Rule 25-22.056(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, provided the Commission affords such relief. Other parties

exceeding said limit without relief from the Commission, however, should not be permitted to do so.

3. Because position summaries are incorporated directly into staff's post hearing recommendation to the Commission, and the parties are not otherwise allowed to address the Commission when the Commissioners vote on the issues, it is unfair for some parties to exceed the Commission's position summary rule by as much as fifty percent, without Commission approval, while the remaining parties comply with the word limitations. 1

WHEREFORE, Time Warner respectfully submits its response for consideration by the Commission concerning the word limitation on post hearing position statement summaries.
