1. The Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission has issued certain requests for documents dated December 27, 1994 and January 17, 1995, in connection with the Audit of Accounting for CPE. The Staff has requested that Southern Bell furnish the following information:

2. Item No 12 - "Section 1.1 states agreement was to terminate on 9/30/94. (1) Was it terminated? (2) If yes, how is BST now marketing CPE to residential customers?"

The information requested includes contract information with a vendor and competitive pricing information related to unregulated CPE operations which are clearly proprietary due to the competitive nature of this service. Such information is specifically considered to be proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to § 364.183(3), (3)(d) and (3)(e), Florida Statutes.
