## PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF GULF POWER COMPANY REGARDING ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Gulf Power Company, ("Gulf Power", "Gulf", or "the "Company"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this preliminary statement of issues and positions, saying:

### Generic Environmental Cost Recovery Issues

ISSUE 1: What are the appropriate final environmental cost recovery true-up amounts for the period April, 1994 through September, 1994?

GULF: Over recovery \$72,442. (Vick, Cranmer)

ISSUE 2: What are the estimated environmental cost recovery true-up amounts for the period October, 1994 through March, 1995?

GULF: Over recovery \$312,005. (Vick, Cranmer)

ISSUE 3: What are the total environmental cost recovery true-up amounts to be collected/refunded during the period April, 1995 through September, 1995?

GULF: Refund of \$384,447. (excluding revenue taxes).
(Cranmer)

ISSUE 4: What are the appropriate projected environmental cost amounts to be included in the recovery factors for the period April, 1995 through September, 1995?

<u>GULF:</u> \$5,756,000. (Vick, Cranmer)

ISSUE 5: What are the appropriate Environmental Cost Recovery Factors for each rate group?

GULF: See table below: (Cranmer)

The recovery factor applicable to customers taking service under Rate Schedule SBS shall be determined as follows: customers with a Contract Demand in the range of 100 to 499 KW will use the recovery factor applicable to Rate Schedule GSD; customers with a Contract Demand in the range of 500 to 7,499 KW will use the recovery factor applicable to Rate Schedule LP; and customers with a Contract Demand over 7,499 KW will use the recovery factor applicable to Rate Schedule PX.

ISSUE 6: What should be the effective date of the new environmental cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

GULF: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified billing cycle and thereafter for the period April, 1995, through September, 1995. Billing cycles may start before April 1, 1995, and the last cycle may be read after September 30, 1995, so that each customer is billed for six months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective. (Cranmer)
