The above-referenced Original Water Certificate Application Notice has been reviewed by this office, and based upon information contained in the application and on local knowledge, has been found Regionally Significant And Consistent with adopted goals, objectives, and policies of the Regional Comprehensive Policy Plan. Project consistency is based on the following:

1. The Certificate Application should not be construed as providing for service in any areas other than those areas included within the Notice.
2. The Certificate Application includes proposed service areas within the approved University Lakes and University Place Developments of Regional Impact. The Application Consistency finding should not be construed as an approval, by the Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council, of development within the DRIs other than that which has already been approved by Manatee and Sarasota Counties.

This recommendation will be discussed at the next scheduled Council meeting. Should Council action differ from the staff recommendation, you will be notified.
