

**D. STATEMENT OF BASIC POSITION**

West Florida Natural Gas Company has properly calculated its true-up amounts and projected gas costs. Its costs and projections are reasonable and its purchased gas cost recovery factor should be approved.

**E. STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS**

**ISSUE 1:** What are the appropriate final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period October, 1993 through March, 1994?

WFNG'S Position: \$329,323 underrecovery.

**ISSUE 2:** What are the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period April, 1994 through March, 1995?

WFNG'S Position: \$1,020,347 underrecovery.

ISSUE 3: What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the period April, 1995 through March, 1996?

WFNG'S Position: \$270,355 overrecovery.

ISSUE 4: What are the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period April, 1995 through March, 1996?

WFNG'S Position: 36.460 cents per therm.


ISSUE 5: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

WFNG'S Position: Agrees with Staff.
