Lake Cogen owns and operates a 112 MW gas-fired cogeneration facility (the "Lake Facility") in Umatilla, Lake County, Florida, and sells firm capacity and energy from the facility to FLORIDA POWER CORPORATION ("Florida Power," "FPC") pursuant to that certain Negotiated Contract For The Purchase Of Firm Capacity And Energy From A Qualifying Facility between Lake Cogen and FPC dated March 13, 1991 (the "Contract"). Thermal energy produced by the Lake Facility is sold, in the form of steam, to Golden Gem Growers, Inc. for use in its citrus processing plant. Lake Cogen is a "qualifying facility" or "QF" as contemplated by the applicable rules of the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (the "FERC"). The Contract was approved for cost recovery by Commission Order No. 24734, issued on July 1, 1991 in Docket No. 910401-EQ.
- 4. On October 14, 1994, Lake and FPC entered into a letter agreement to re-confirm and memorialize in writing their understanding and agreement with respect to certain aspects of Lake's operations in its performance of the Contract. Specifically, Lake agreed to change the normal operating procedure of the Lake Facility so that its output to FPC will be 95 MW during all off-peak hours under normal operating conditions; FPC agreed to include Lake as a Group A Non-Utility Generator under FPC's proposed Curtailment Plan.
- 5. By its Second Supplemental Filing to Petition for Approval, to the Extent Required, of Certain Actions Relating to Approved Cogeneration Contracts, filed herein on November 16, 1994, FPC seeks the Commission's approval of the aforementioned October

14 letter agreement between Lake and PPC. By the same filing, PPC also seeks the Commission's approval of certain other actions expressly authorized within the Contract, including FPC's consent to assignment as security in connection with financing, PPC's agreement to certain extensions of milestone dates due to regulatory delays, and Lake's increase in the Committed Capacity to be delivered to FPC under the Contract. Accordingly, Lake's substantial interests will be subject to determination by the Commission's action herein and will be affected by the Commission's decision on this matter.

WHEREFORE, LAKE COGEN prays the Commission to enter its Order granting this Petition for Leave to Intervene and directing that copies of all pleadings, notices, orders, and other communications filed, given, or entered herein be furnished to the persons named in Paragraph 2 hereof.
