COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company") and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Motion for Extension of Duration of Order Granting Confidential Classification, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

1. On February 4, 1993 Southern Bell filed a Request for Confidential Classification for portions of the testimony and exhibits of Mark N. Cooper on behalf of the Office of Public Counsel, Earl Poucher on behalf of the Office of Public Counsel and Michael R. Maloy on behalf of the Attorney General. The Commission assigned Document No. 1410-93 to this material.

2. By an Order issued December 1, 1993, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") granted in part and denied in part Southern Bell's Request for Confidential Classification of portions of the testimony and exhibits. (Order No. PSC-93-1731-CFO-TL) Specifically, the Commission approved Southern Bell's request for confidential classification for revenue expense and demand information, an employees social security number and specific market segment information.

3. Under the provision of Rule 25-22.006 (8) (a), an order granting confidential classification is effective for 18 months. Therefore, the confidential classification granted in this Order expires on June 1, 1995. The Commission may, however, extend the period of confidentiality for good cause shown.

4. The information in question remains in the possession of the Staff.

5. The reasons Southern Bell asserted in support of confidential treatment in its original motion continue to pertain. Specifically, there is still a need to protect employee personal information, revenue and expense information for inside wire services and specific market segment information from disclosure.

6. For the reasons set forth above and in the two original Request for Confidential Classification filed on February 4, 1993, Southern Bell hereby requests that this Commission enter an Order extending the period of confidential classification for an additional 18 months, or for any longer period of time that the documents remain within the possession of staff.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Southern Bell respectfully requests the entry of an Order extending the period of confidential classification as described above.
