### PETITION OF TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the company's proposals concerning fuel adjustment, capacity cost recovery, generating performance incentive factor and oil backout cost recovery, set forth herein. In support thereof says:

#### Fuel Adjustment

- Tampa Electric has calculated that it experienced a final true-up amount for the October 1, 1994 through March 31, 1995 period of an over/(under)-recovery of (\$5,963,794). (See Exhibit No. (MJP-1), Document No. 1, page 1 of 1.)
- amount for the period April 1, 1995 through September 30, 1995, which is based upon actual data for the period April 1, 1995 through May 31, 1995 and revised estimates for the period June 1, 1995 through September 30, 1995 to be an over/(under)-recovery of (\$2,961,361). This (\$2,961,361) over/(under)-recovery, plus the final true-up amount for the October 1, 1994 March 31, 1995 period of an over/(under)-recovery of (\$5,963,794), produces an end of period total net true-up of (\$8,925,155) over/(under)-recovery as of 5 ptember 30, 1995.

FPSC-RECORDS/REPORTING

3. The company's projected expenditures for the period October 1, 1995 through March 31, 1996, when adjusted for the proposed GPIF reward and the true-up over/(under)recovery amount and spread over projected kilowatt hour sales for the period October 1, 1995 through March 31, 1996, produce a fuel adjustment factor for the new period of 2.365 cents per KWH before application of the factors which adjust for variations in line losses. (See Exhibit No. (MJP-2), Schedule E-1E.)

### Capacity Cost Recovery

- 4. Tampa Electric has calculated that it experienced a final true-up amount for the October 1, 1994 through March 31, 1995 period of an over/(under)-recovery of (\$667,853). (See Exhibit No. (MJP-1), Document No. 3, page 2 of 5.)
- amount for the period April 1, 1995 through September 30 1995, which is based upon actual data for the period April 1, 1995 through May 31, 1995 and revised estimates for the period June 1, 1995 through September 30, 1995 to be an over/(under)-recovery of \$622,234. This \$622,234 over/(under)-recovery, plus the final true-up amount for the October 1, 1994 through Harch 31, 1995 period of an over/(under)-recovery of (\$667,853), produces an end of period total net true-up of (\$45,619) over/(under)-recovery as of September 30, 1995.
- 6. The company's projected expenditures for the period October 1, 1995 through March 31, 1996, when adjusted for the true-up over/(under)-recovery amount and spread over projected kilowatt

hour sales for the period October 1, 1995 through March 31, 1996 produce a capacity cost recovery factor for the new period of .168 cents per KWH before applying the 12 CP & 1/13 allocation methodology, and producing the capacity recovery factors by rate schedule. (See Exhibit No. (MJP-3), page 3 of 5).

#### GPIF

- 7. Tampa Electric has calculated that it is subject to a GPIF penalty of (\$471,209) (adjusted to include regulatory assessment fee of one-twelfth of one-percent) for performance experienced during the period October 1, 1994 through March 31, 1995.
- 8. The company is also proposing GPIF targets and ranges to be applied to the period October 1, 1995 through March 31, 1996 with such proposed targets and ranges being detailed in testimony and exhibits filed herewith.

#### oil Backout Cost Recovery

- During the period April 1995 September 1995, Tampa Electric carried an end of period net true-up amount of an over/(under)-recovery of \$222,410.
- 10. The company now estimates it will require a \$686,843 over/(under)-recovery true-up provision for the six months ending September 1995.
- 11. The total oil backout true-up amount to be included during the period October 1995 through December 1995 is a \$909,253 over/(under)-recovery.

relative to the six month period ending December 31, 1995, Tampa Electric has calculated that its appropriate oil backout cost recovery factor for application during the period October 1995 - December 1995 is .58 cents per KWH. (See Exhibit No. (WNC/EAT-2), Document 1, page 1.)
