RE: DOCKET NO. 950495-WS - Application for rate increase and increase in service availability charges by Southern States Utilities, Inc. for Orange-Osceola Utilities, Inc. in Osceola County, and in Bradford, Brevard, Charlotte, Citrus, Clay, Collier, Duval, Highlands, Lake, Lee, Marion, Martin, Nassau, Orange, Osceola, Pasco, Putnam, Seminole, St. Johns, St. Lucie, Volusia, and Washington Counties.

Issue 1: Recommendation that the exclusion of Hernando, Hillsborough and Polk Counties from SSU's application does constitute a deficiency. Although the information is not specifically required by Rules 25-30.433, 25-30.436, and 25-30.437, F.A.C., the utility's request for uniform rates cannot be processed without the information for and the inclusion of Hillsborough, Polk and Hernando Counties. Accordingly, SSU should be required to modify its filing to include those counties in its request for uniform rates.
