Pursuant to Section 364.16(4), Florida Statutes, this Commission is required to establish a temporary number portability solution by no later than January 1, 1996, if the parties to this proceeding are unable to successfully negotiate the prices, terms, and conditions of a temporary number portability solution. The issues of material fact in dispute in this proceeding have been tentatively identified by the Commission in its July 25, 1995 Order Establishing Procedure in this docket. Order No. PSC-95-0896-PCO-TP at App. A.

4. As an Alternative Access Vendor that has given notice of its intent to provide local exchange service in Florida, MFS-FL has substantial interests that are subject to determination and will be affected through this temporary local number portability proceeding.

WHEREFORE Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. respectfully requests that it be allowed to intervene in this proceeding.
