Thank you for your letter dated August 25, 1995, in support of Southern Bell's proposal to implement extended calling service (ECS) on a number of routes in South Dade County.

The Commission conducted a hearing on Southern Bell's proposal on July 31, 1995, and is scheduled to render a decision at its September 12, 1995, agenda conference. A final order is scheduled to be issued September 29, 1995. Parties to the proceeding may request reconsideration of the Commission's decision and may appeal the decision to the Florida Supreme Court.

I am unable to comment on the merits of the company's proposal while this matter is pending. I will, however, place your letter on the correspondence side of the docket file where it will be available for review by the parties to the proceeding.
