As a certificated IXC, AT&T is subject to the rules, regulations, and orders of the Commission, and such rules, regulations, and orders impact AT&T's ability to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service.


4. The above-referenced docket was opened for the purpose of resolving petition(s) to establish nondiscriminatory rates, terms, and conditions for interconnection involving local exchange companies (hereinafter "LECs") and alternative local exchange companies (hereinafter "ALECs") pursuant to recent revisions to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. As an IXC, AT&T must use the local access services of LECs and will potentially use the local access services of ALECs to reach its customers. The issues in this docket could impact, either directly or indirectly, those services and AT&T's ability to deliver interexchange services to its customers.


