COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company") and files pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), Florida Administrative Code, its Seventh Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification ("Seventh Notice").

1. The Florida Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff") has orally requested cost data relating to BellSouth's switched access local transport tariff filing made in response to Commission Order No. PSC-95-0034-FOF-TP issued January 9, 1995. Some of the information contained in the data requested is considered by BellSouth to be confidential proprietary business information and as such must be protected from disclosure. For example, the data contains Florida specific costs of switched access local transport services. Disclosure would be harmful to the business interests of BellSouth. BellSouth will file, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006 and after 21 days, its request for confidential treatment of the proprietary information contained in the data.

2. Because the data contain exempt information, BellSouth is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida
