

**SSU'S TENTH MOTION

1. SSU has provided Late Filed Deposition Exhibit No. 6 of John B. Whitcomb, Ph.D. to the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"). Dr. Whitcomb's Late Filed Deposition Exhibit No. 6 consists of a copy of the draft of Dr. Whitcomb's article entitled "Water Conserving Connection Fees." This draft article contains information which SSU claims is proprietary confidential business information, and is of a type this Commission has found in past dockets to be confidential. SSU believes that this information is within the scope of Section 367.156(3), Florida Statutes, and must be afforded protection as proprietary confidential business information.


