

Please be advised that this firm and the firm of Brickfield, Burchette & Ritts, P.C. have been representing the interests of Florida Steel Corporation, a large electric customer of Florida utilities in numerous dockets before the Florida Public Service Commission ("PSC").

We were aware of the dispute in this docket between the Jacksonville Electrical Authority ("JEA") and Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") regarding utility services in St. Johns County. It has recently come to our attention that the proposed settlement submitted by the two utilities was expanded to include Duval, Clay and Nassau counties, as well as St. Johns County.
