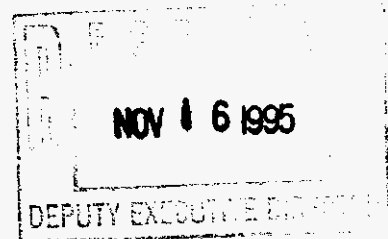

Please be advised that this firm and the firm of Brickfield, Burchette & Ritts, P.C. have been representing the interests of Florida Steel Corporation, a large electric customer of Florida utilities in numerous dockets before the Florida Public Service Commission ("PSC").

We were aware of the dispute in this docket between the Jacksonville Electrical Authority ("JEA") and Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") regarding utility services in St. Johns County. It has recently come to our attention that the proposed settlement submitted by the two utilities was expanded to include Duval, Clay and Nassau counties, as well as St. Johns County. Florida Steel's Baldwin plant is located in Duval County. The PSC's resolution of this matter may have a direct effect on our client.

The PSC is scheduled to consider the proposed settlement during its November 21, 1995 session. We request that the PSC defer consideration of this matter from Tuesday's agenda in order to give us an opportunity to address possible concerns and issues the proposed settlement may pose to Florida Steel. We have advised both JEA and FPL of this request.
