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3. Sprint is an interexchange carrier ("IXC") duly certificated by the Commission to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Florida. As a certificated IXC, Sprint is subject to the rules, regulations, and orders of the Commission, and such rules, regulations, and orders impact Sprint's ability to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service.

4. The above-referenced docket was opened for the purpose of resolving petition(s) to establish nondiscriminatory rates, terms, and conditions for resale involving local exchange companies ("LECs") and alternative local exchange companies ("ALECs") pursuant to recent revisions to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. 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
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
