Dear Mr. Rosko:

Rosko Manor's water system is permitted by HRS-Citrus County Public Health Unit and is a 10D-4 Limited Use Commercial Water System.

As the owner and operator of the Limited Use Commercial Water System you are required to submit a quarterly bacteriological water sample, and every three years you are required to have your finished water system chemically analyzed.

Your water system is in compliance at the present time.

NOTE: A Limited Use Community Water system can have up to 14 connections. It presently has 8 connections, but in order to develop property on lots less than one acre in size that were subdivided after January 1, 1972, Florida Statute 381 requires a central water system permitted under the jurisdiction of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. The water system would have to meet the requirements of the Department of Environmental Protection to issue OSTDS (septic tank permits) for further development beyond what it has at the present time.
