RESELLER METHODOLOGY

- o Requirement for installation of meters
- o Allocation based on hot water usage
- o Allocation based on square footage, number of rooms, number of bathrooms, etc.
- o Allocation of fixed or base facility charges
- o Allocation of common area water and wastewater usage

CUSTOMER DEPOSITS, MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES, DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

NEED FOR STATUTORY CHANGES

- o Regulatory status of resellers
- o Conservation incentive--recovery of meter installation expenses
- o Conservation incentive--recovery of maintenance and operating expenses over purchased water and wastewater cost
- o Requirement for all dwellings to be individually metered
 - existing construction
 - new construction

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JURISDICTION
