This small utility cannot afford to pay the RAF unless we pay from cash flow monthly throughout this year, or bill each user a pro-rata share.

I have loaned this utility \$5500.00, plus \$2000.00 in the last six months to pay it's ongoing operations expenses.

We have been gravely affected by Hurricane Opal. The storm surge damaged over two hundred of the mobile homes in the park served by the utility. The insurance company has totaled many of those homes and the residents have moved. The lots are now vacant, and no base facility charge or monthly meter fee is being collected. We have applied for an S.B.A. Disaster loan.

Please let me know if there is any way the P.S.C. can work with us in this time of crisis.
