- The installation of 178 individual 3/4" water meters to the primary feed to each unit.
- Read each meter on a monthly basis;
- Bill each resident monthly, per 1000g of water and waste water usage, as per the above published rate schedule.
- Approx. 10 days will lapse between the time the meters are read and bills are mailed
- A refundable \$30.00 deposit will be required for each unit which will be collected by the reseller
- There will be no common area charges billed to the residents
- There will be no miscellaneous fees billed to the residents.
- The cost of the billing service is paid directly by the reseller and not charged to the residents
