A16.2 PERSONAL PAGING SERVICE (PPS)

A16.2.1 General

- A. Personal Paging Service will allow the subscriber of this service to receive a one-way radio signal that activates a pager when an assigned, conventional seven-digit telephone number is dialed. It is offered in Tone, ~~Tone & Voice~~, and Tone & Digital Display. (D)
- B. A Personal Paging Service agreement shall be executed prior to the establishment of service.
- C. Personal Paging Service subscribers will not receive a directory listing for the name or receiver number.
- D. Service Connection Charges apply as applicable in Section A4 of this tariff.

A16.2.2 Definitions

- A. Tone Only - A class of paging service that alerts the subscriber of a page by a moderately loud "beeping" tone.
- ~~B. Tone & Voice - A class of paging service that alerts the subscriber of a page by a moderately loud "beeping" tone. The service provides a fixed "on the air" time to allow the calling party to deliver a verbal message. (D)~~
- ~~C. Tone & Digital Display - A class of paging service that alerts the subscriber of a page by a moderately loud "beeping" tone. The service provides a fixed "on the air" time to allow the calling party to deliver up to a ten-digit display. (C)~~

~~-B-~~ C. Paging Number - The seven-digit telephone number assigned to a given pager. (C)

A16.2.3 Availability

A. Personal Paging Service is available to pocket receivers equipped for service within the range of a base station through which such service is furnished, subject to transmission, atmospheric and like limitations. Due to the inconsistencies of high-frequency radio propagation, communications may be unobtainable in some areas, even though surrounded by strong signal locations. In no event shall the Company be liable for any damage of any kind or nature in connection with, or arising out of, the existence, furnishing, functioning, or customer's use of any item of equipment or services provided.
