Gentlemen:

This letter is in response to an undated notice found in our newspaper delivery box on the morning of Friday, February 9, 1996. Since this notice was an unexplained 'legalese' description of property in Marion and Sumter Counties and titled "Application for Extension of Service Area" for water and sewer service, we assume it includes our property at the address shown below. We trust this DOES NOT MEAN we will be forced into having severs at our location.

When we started final negotiations for the building of our home in Spruce Creek in early 1990, we were assured that the community had been approved for 'so many' houses ok'd for septic, and that our lot and phase fell into that number. Any additional homes over this allotted number would have to be hooked up to a then-as-yet unbuilt sever system. This was fine with us - we vere no strangers to septic systems; furthermore, we DO NOT have individual water wells to be concerned about with the septic fields

Spruce Creek went on to build MANY more houses than originally described to us, and to install a sever system for these new phases. All who purchased these homes knew they would have severs, just as we knew we would have septic. We surely DO NOT want to be forced now to have sever, when we have absolutely no problems with our present septic system. On the contrary, the sever system seems to cause more problems than our septics. We also do not want the further financial burden of a sever bill, which was not in our original budget when we purchased.

On Monday, February 12, 1996 I spoke with Mr. Steve Decker in Spruce Creek South Utilities, Billing, who was designated to answer the expected queries regarding this unexplained notice. He assured me that this notice was just to notify the State of the entire single property lines for all 924.51 acres comprising Spruce Creek South, and that S.C. had no intention of any further expansion of the sever system in this community. He emphasized to me that S.C.S. did not initiate any action to connect individual existing septic systems to their sewers. He also stated this notice will not cost residents any money.

We want to go on record that if this notice (which was placed in our paper box sometime late Friday night or early Saturday morning [Feb. 9 & 10]) is to extend any further vater or sever service to the area described, we are opposed to this application. If this notice is only a form to define the boundaries as stated above by Mr. Decker, we have no objection to AFA _____ this application.
