RE: DOCKET NO. 950495-WS - Application for rate increase and increase in service availability charges by Southern States Utilities, Inc. for Orange-Osceola Utilities, Inc. in Osceola County, and in Bradford, Brevard, Charlotte, Citrus, Clay, Collier, Duval, Highlands, Lake, Lee, Marion, Martin, Nassau, Orange, Osceola, Pasco, Putnam, Seminole, St. Johns, St. Lucie, Volusia, and Washington Counties.

Issue 1: Should the petition of the Board of Supervisors of the East County Water Control District for leave to intervene be granted?

Recommendation: Yes, the Board's petition for leave to intervene should be granted to the extent that it requests permission to intervene itself as a customer of SSU. However, the Board should not be permitted to intervene on behalf of all of the taxpayers or ratepayers of the East County Water Control District. Moreover, the requests that parties be directed to serve the District with all previously filed documents and that all documents be served upon the District's vice-president, in addition to the Board's counsel of record, should be denied.
