Dear Mr. Gatlin:

We have received your letter dated March 8, 1996, requesting approval to use a projected test year ended December 31, 1996, with an historic base year ended December 31, 1995. Your test year request as outlined above is hereby approved. You should also be aware that prefiled direct testimony must be filed with the minimum filing requirements if you do not elect to request the proposed agency action process.

For administrative purposes only, Docket No. 960329-WS has been assigned to the forthcoming case. Your petition will be deemed filed on the date that the Division of Records and Reporting receives the complete petition, revised tariff sheets, the minimum filing requirements, testimony (if not requesting PAA) and the filing fee. To minimize any regulatory lag that may occur, we request that you file the above no later than July 31, 1996. Because of the difficulty in scheduling hearing dates it is not anticipated that an extension of this filing date will be granted.

Under the file and suspend law, the time period for processing the request will begin on the date that all of the required data is completely filed. If not complete, the official filing date will be the date the complete corrections to the deficiencies are filed. The utility is instructed to file all information it wishes the Commission to consider when arriving at a decision on its rate case application with its original filing. Because of the time limitations contained in Section 367.081, Florida Statutes, and the lengthy auditing and investigation required, information not filed with the original application may not be considered. Lastly, the
