DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should Quincy Telephone's request to eliminate its Mobile Interconnection tariff be approved?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes, Quincy's request to eliminate its Mobile Interconnection tariff should be approved effective April 30, 1996.

STAFF ANALYSIS: Quincy currently has no customers subscribing to its mobile interconnection tariff. The Company requests that it be allowed to delete this offering so as to avoid needless updating. Quincy has stated that it will refile a tariff in compliance with Order No. PSC-96-0132-FOF-TL in DN 940235-TL, the Commission's most recent investigation into the appropriate rates, terms and conditions for mobile interconnection traffic, when someone requests the service. In keeping with the intent of the revisions to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, regarding the streamlining of regulation for small LECs, and our subsequent rule proceeding, staff recommends that Quincy's request be approved.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes, if Issue 1 is approved, elimination of this tariff should become effective April 30, 1996. STAFF ANALYSIS: If the Commission approves Issue 1, elimination of this tariff should become effective April 30, 1996. If a protest is filed within 21 days from the issuance date of the order, the tariff should remain in effect pending resolution of the protest. If no timely protest is filed, this docket should be closed.
