On April 22, 1996, in response to Document Request No. 317 served by the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"), SSU provided OPC with a copy of the 1991 federal income tax return and associated documents of Topeka Group Incorporated together with supporting work papers. SSU maintains that these documents contain information of the type which the Commission has found to be confidential in the past. See Order No. PSC-95-1286-CFO-WS issued in this docket. Once the review is completed, OPC will notify SSU of the materials and information it intends to use in this docket, and SSU, in accordance with Rule 25-22.006(6)(a) and (c), Florida will request proprietary confidential Administrative Code, treatment of those portions of the materials and information which are, in its opinion, entitled to such treatment. The remainder of any such materials and information which OPC has taken possession of pursuant to this Temporary Protective Order will be returned to SSU by OPC pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(c).

WHEREFORE, SSU respectfully moves the Commission for a Temporary Protective Order covering the above described documents provided to OPC.
