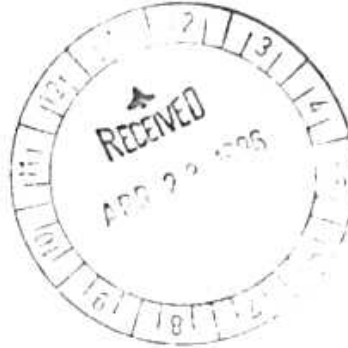

6.3 APPLICATION OF SERVICE CHARGES - Continued

6.3.9 Service Charges do not apply to:

- a. Installations, moves or changes of public telephones.
- b. Battery or Ringing Supply Circuits.
- c. Service re-established after destruction of the customer's premises by Act of God or a public enemy, whether at the same or another location. Regular Service Charges apply, however, to service re-established in the old locations after termination of service or subsequent to its establishment at another location under the above circumstances.

- d. Directory listings. In addition, no service charges are made for changes made in the directory because of changes in wording in corporate, firm or other names, where the same firm or persons are involved before and after the change, or for the substitution of the name of another member of the family for that already listed in the directory, nor for correction in addresses in the directory.

The re-establishment of service at a location which has been destroyed or made untenable by a disaster such as a hurricane, tornado, fire, flood, etc., when equivalent service is established within a reasonable time. If the subscriber desires service at a new location for a temporary period, then service charges will apply covering the establishment of service at the temporary location, but no service charge will apply when service is re-established at the former location. If the subscriber desires service established at a new and permanent location, then the service charge will apply.

6.4 SERVICE CHARGES FOR INSIDE MOVES AND CHANGES - Continued

6.4.4 Charges for changes requested by the subscriber except as provided hereinafter.

d. For rearrangement of drop wire and/or protector, the secondary Service Ordering Charge, the Access Line Charge, the Premise Visit Charge and the Premise Wire Charge applicable to the main station or PBX trunk, as appropriate, will apply.

6.4.5 Charges for moves and changes do not apply to:

- a. Stations for which no exchange service charges apply, i.e., Company stations.
- b. Public telephones or toll stations installed at the initiative of the Company, to meet the public demand for service, provided the move or change is made on the Company's initiative or is, in the judgement of the Company, desirable to better serve the public use of the station.
- c. Moves or changes required for the proper maintenance of the equipment or service.
- d. Moves or changes made at the time of a change in the class of service provided such move or change is necessary because of the change in class of service.
- e. Changes in telephone number made where, in the judgement of the Company, it is necessary for continuation of satisfactory service.
