DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

STAFF ANALYSIS:

Tariff Description

The purpose of St. Joseph Telephone & Telegraph Company's (St. Joe or the Company) filing is to clarify the tariff language regarding the re-establishment of service at a location destroyed or made unlivable by a disaster.

service occurs due to destruction from a natural disaster. With this filing, the Company proposes to no longer apply service connection charges when service is re-established at the damaged location. However, if a customer desires service temporarily at a new location, then regular service charges will still apply.

Recommendation

The Company proposes not to reassess service connection charges at locations damaged by a natural disaster. This tariff change is clearly beneficial to end users. For this reason, staff recommends approval of this filing.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?
