**FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL  
TIME TO FILE ITS REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests additional time, through and including May 24, 1996, to file a request for confidential classification with respect to certain information provided to Staff in connection with Staff's audit of Martin Plant Combined Cycle Units 3 & 4.

The basis of this motion is set forth below:

1. Pursuant to the letter of May 2, 1996 from Denise N. Vandiver, Chief, Bureau of Auditing, a request for confidential classification related to the subject audit is due to be filed on May 17, 1996.

2. The materials provided by FPL are voluminous consisting of seven volumes and more than 700 pages. FPL has already provided the information to Staff and also previously filed a notice of intent to seek confidential treatment of the subject documents. However, because of the sheer volume of the documents, FPL anticipates that it will be unable to complete the page by page and line by line correlation required by Rule 25-22.006(4) by May 17, 1996.

3. The materials provided are presumptively entitled to confidential treatment pursuant to sections 366.093(b) & (d) of the Florida Statutes. Disclosure would harm FPL and its customers.
