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

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PURPOSE

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BACKGROUND

Colony Park Utilities, Inc. is a Class C wastewater only utility located in Brevard County. It provides service to approximately 301 wastewater customers.

The test period for setting rates is the historical average twelve month period ending December 31, 1995. According to the staff audit and preliminary analysis, the utility's test year revenues were \$35,628. Test year operating expenses were \$46,673. The resulting net loss is (\$11,045).

CURRENT AND PRELIMINARY RATES AND CHARGES

Staff has compiled the following rates and charges for the purpose of discussion at the customer meeting. These rates are preliminary and subject to change based on information gathered at the customer meeting, further staff review, and the final decision by the Commissioners. The utility's current and staff's preliminary rates and charges for staff's recommendation are as follows:

After the meeting, staff will prepare and submit a recommendation to the Commission. The Commission will thereafter issue a proposed agency action order containing rates which may be different from those contained in staff's final recommendation. Five to ten customers or persons who attend the meeting and who wish to receive a copy of the recommendation and the order may so indicate at the meeting. Those individuals are expected to distribute the information in the recommendation and the order to other customers and interested persons.
