

Dear Mr. Devlin:

On October 13, 1995, Robert M. Post, Jr. requested permission on behalf of Indiantown Telephone System, Inc. to delay filing the company capital recovery study until May 31, 1996. It now appears that the company should have requested until June 30, 1996, in order to obviate the need for filing in the event that Indiantown Telephone System, Inc. should choose price regulation within the first six months that the new Florida law is in effect.

If there are any problems with this extension request, please let me know so that the company can advise the staff of the lives chosen for each category of depreciable plant, thereby permitting the staff to proceed with establishment of depreciation rates under the newly adopted depreciation rules.
