M.T.K. Investments, Inc.

On May 17, 1996, a petition for non-jurisdictional exemption from regulation by the Florida Public Service Commission was filed on behalf of M.T.K. Investments, Inc. (M.T.K. Investments) pursuant to Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes. M.T.K Investments is owned by Mark A. Aller. The application was signed by Mr. Mark A. Aller as president of M.T.K. Investments and as primary contact person. The mailing address for M.T.K. and for Mr. Aller is P.O. Box 2815, Crystal River, Florida 34423 (352/344-8279). The physical address and service territory for M.T.K. is S.R. 200 & S.W. 80th Street, Ocala, Florida 34476. This location is in Marion County.

In accordance with Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.060(30(j), Florida Administrative code, Mr. Aller has signed a statement that M.T.K. Investments will provide water service without compensation and that all costs will be treated and recovered as operational expenses. Wastewater is intended to be handled by septic tank. By signing the application Mr. Aller has acknowledged that he is aware of the penalty pursuant to Section 837.06, Florida Statutes, for knowingly making false statements in writing with the intent to mislead.

APP	requirements and without apparent controversy. Staff therefore recommends that an

Staff also recommends that the order require the current owner, or successors, of M.T.K. Investments to notify the Commission within 30 days of any change in circumstances or method of operation of its water or wastewater system so that the exempt status may be reevaluated. Furthermore, staff recommends that this docket be closed.
