The Florida Public Service Commission announces a workshop to be held by the Florida Public Service Commission, concerning investigation into inverted electric rates, to which all interested persons are invited.

PURPOSE: The purposes of this workshop are as follows:

- 1) To define an inverted rate and the customer charge.
- 2) To discuss the rationale for inverted rates.
- 3) To discuss the conservation effect of an inverted rate, and the potential savings associated with conservation.
- 4) To define potential problems with seasonal customers due to a reduced or eliminated customer charge and to develop possible solutions.
- 5) To discuss the adoption of inverted rates and a reduction or elimination of the customer charge.
- 6) To discuss the phase-in period of an inverted rate / reduced customer charge policy.
