COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), Florida Administrative Code, its Motion for Temporary Protective Order in connection with its Responses to AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc.'s ("AT&T") First Set of Interrogatories dated July 24, 1996.

On August 23, 1996, BellSouth filed its Response to AT&T's First Set of Interrogatories, portions of which are deemed to be confidential and proprietary by BellSouth. Some of the documents that will be delivered to and reviewed by AT&T in connection with these responses to these interrogatories contain proprietary, confidential business information which should not be publicly disclosed.
